Never forget that *life is a gift that must be cared.*

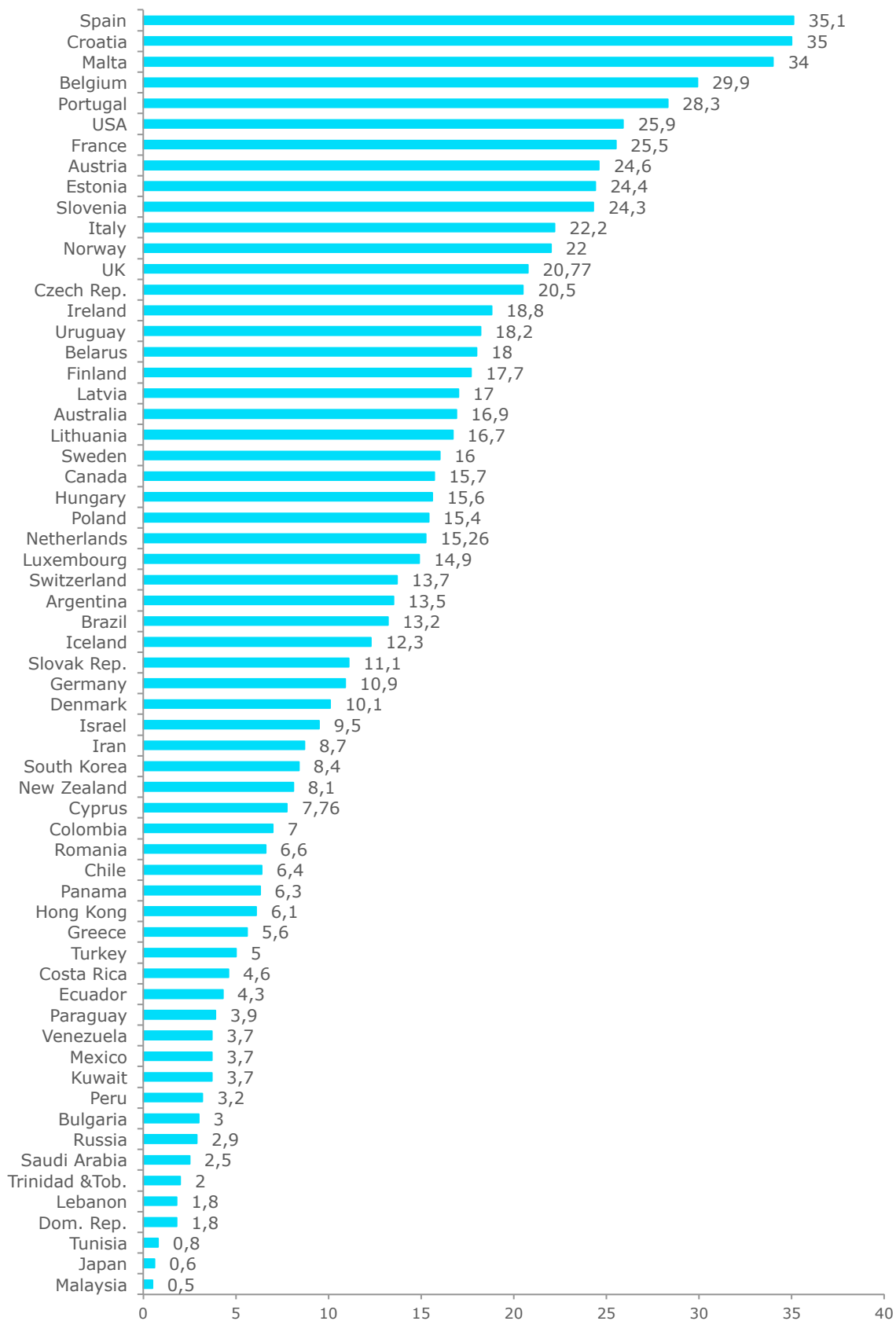

## 1. WORLDWIDE DONATION ACTIVITY

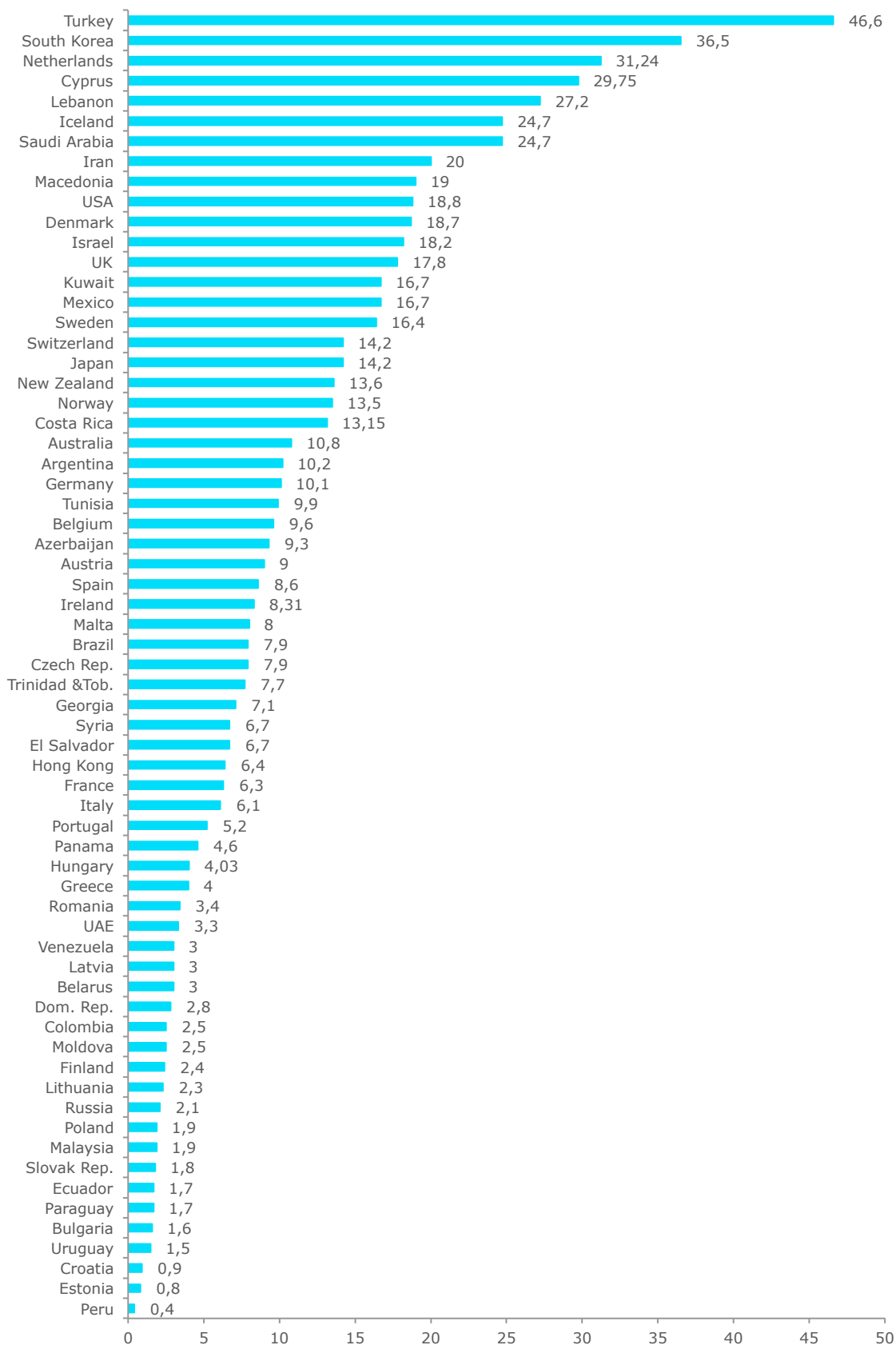

It is also included an extra graph where is represented the numbers of the Organ Donors after Cardiac Death. After those it is showed the same activity separated in four big regions: Europe, America, Asia–Oceania and Africa – Middle East. All of them are compared with the numbers of the previous year 2012.

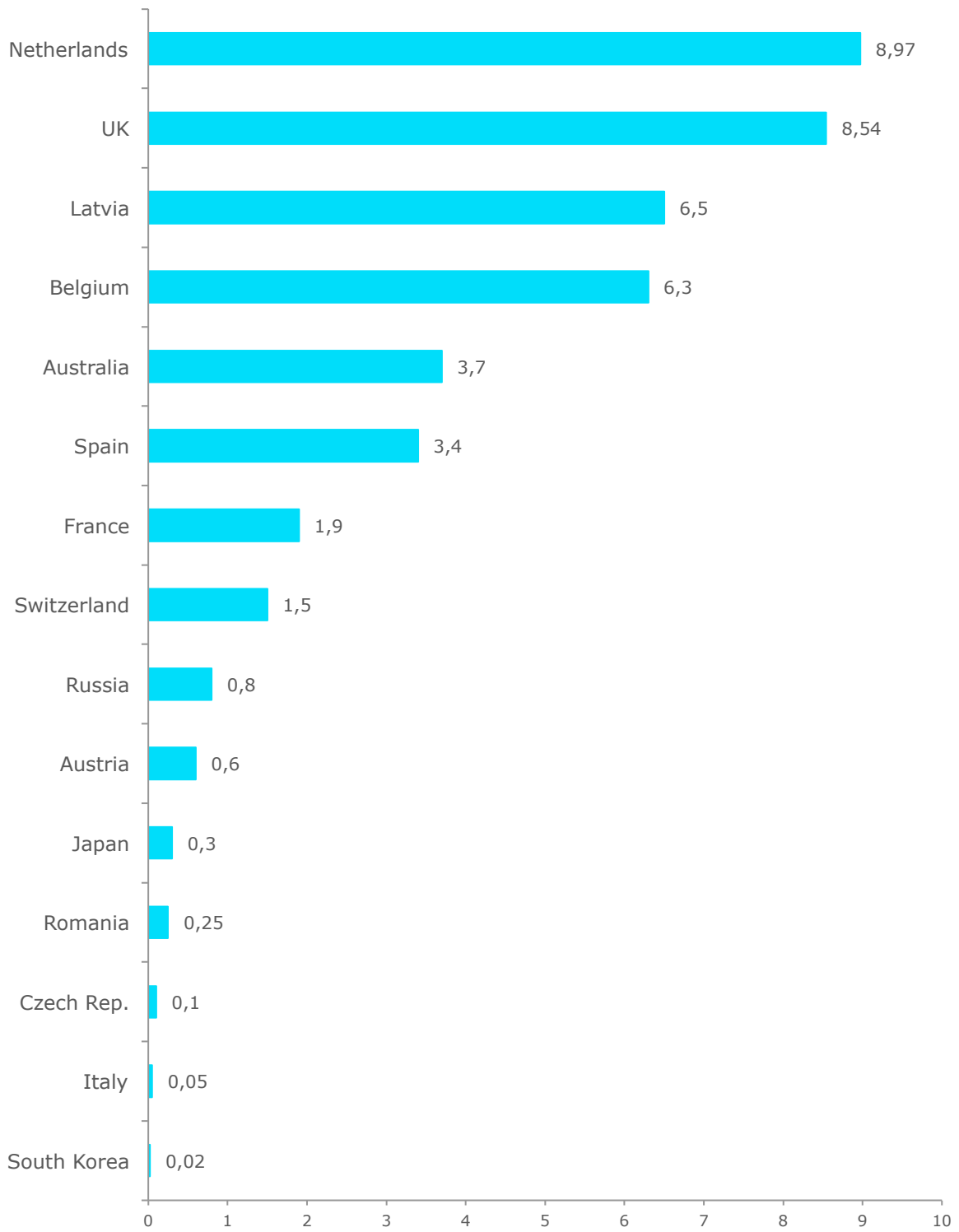

### WORLDWIDE ACTUAL DECEASED ORGAN DONORS 2013 (pmp)

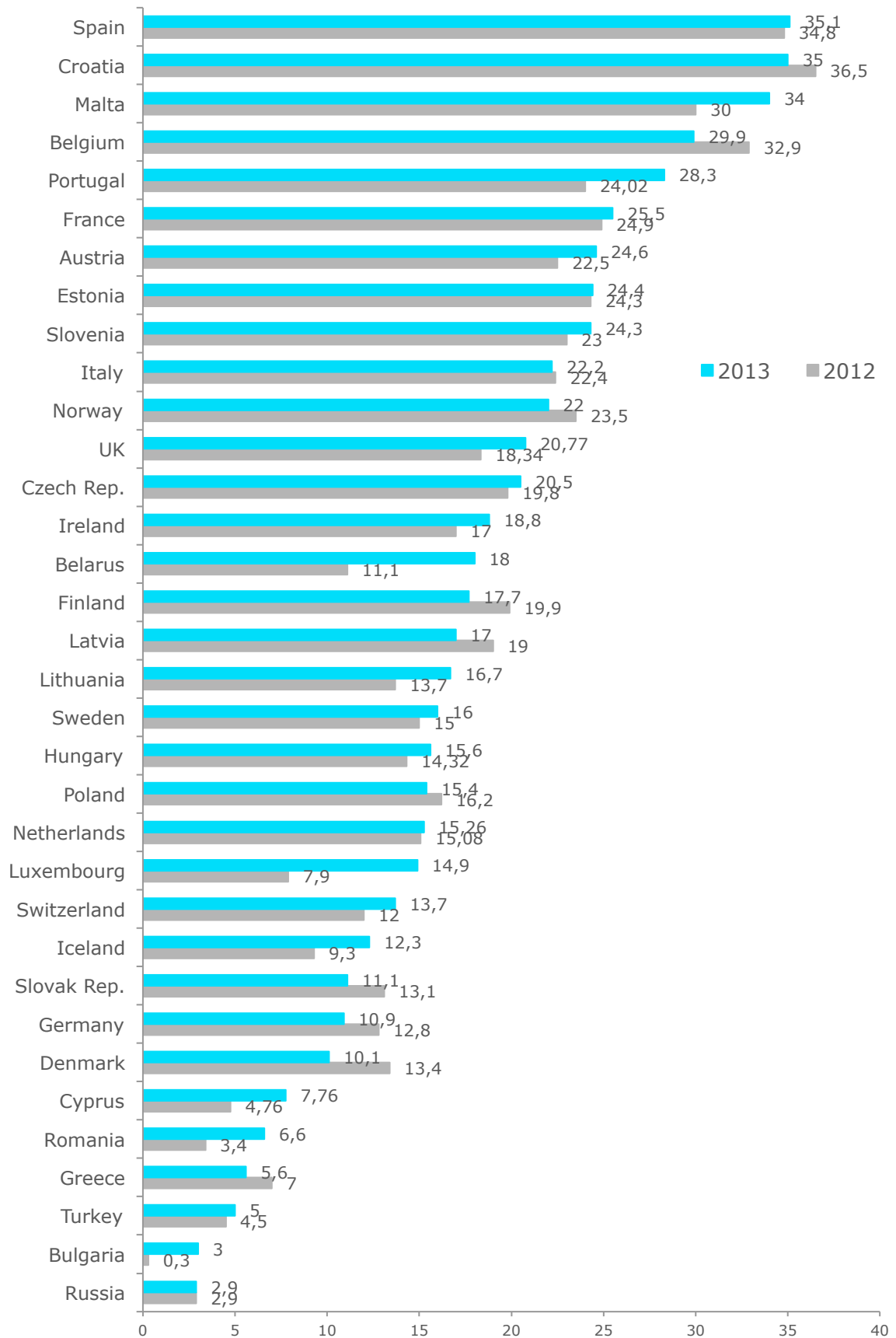


### WORLDWIDE LIVING ORGAN DONORS 2013 (pmp)

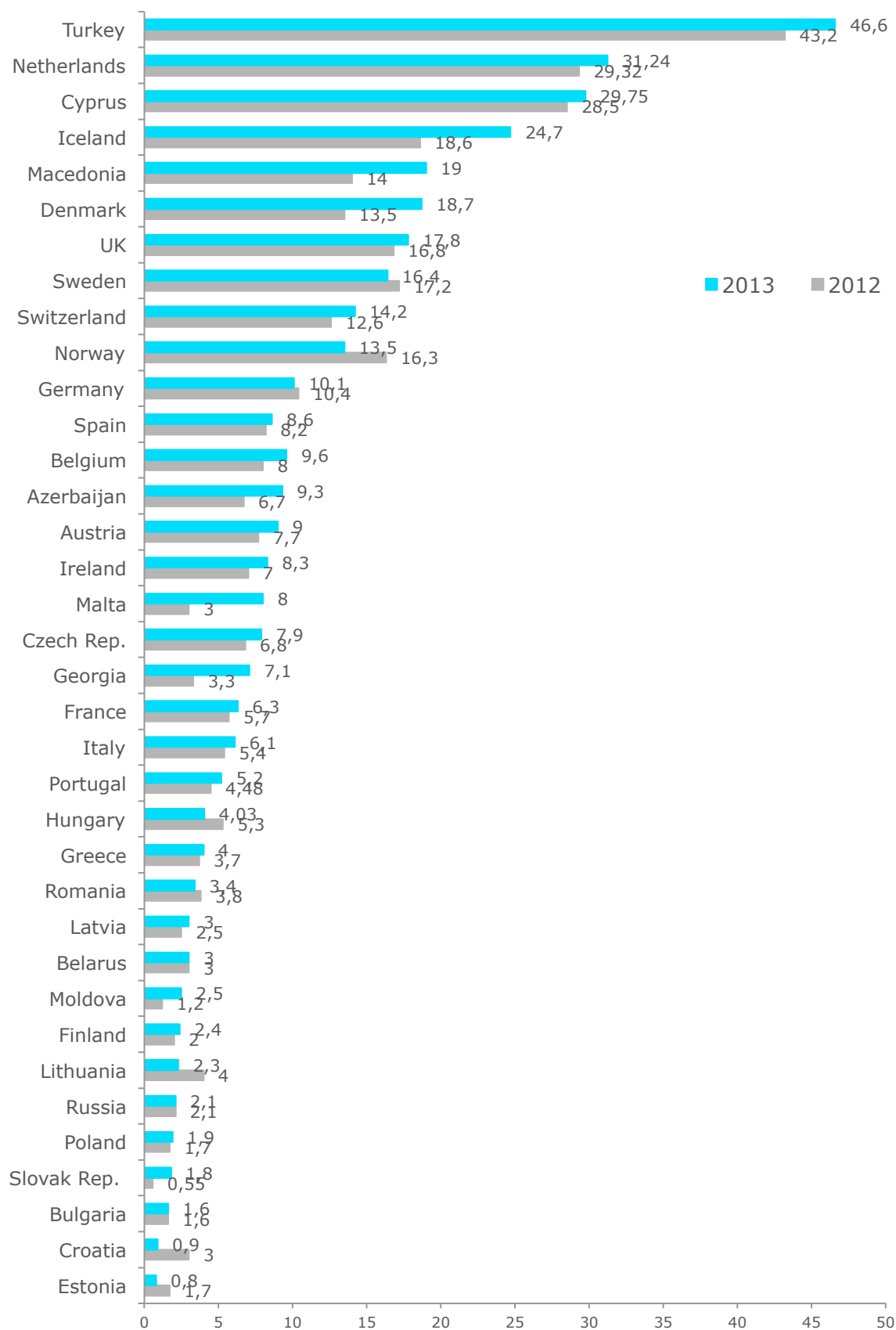


**WORLDWIDE ACTUAL DONORS AFTER CARDIAC DEATH 2013 (pmp)**

### EUROPE ACTUAL DECEASED ORGAN DONORS 2013 (pmp)

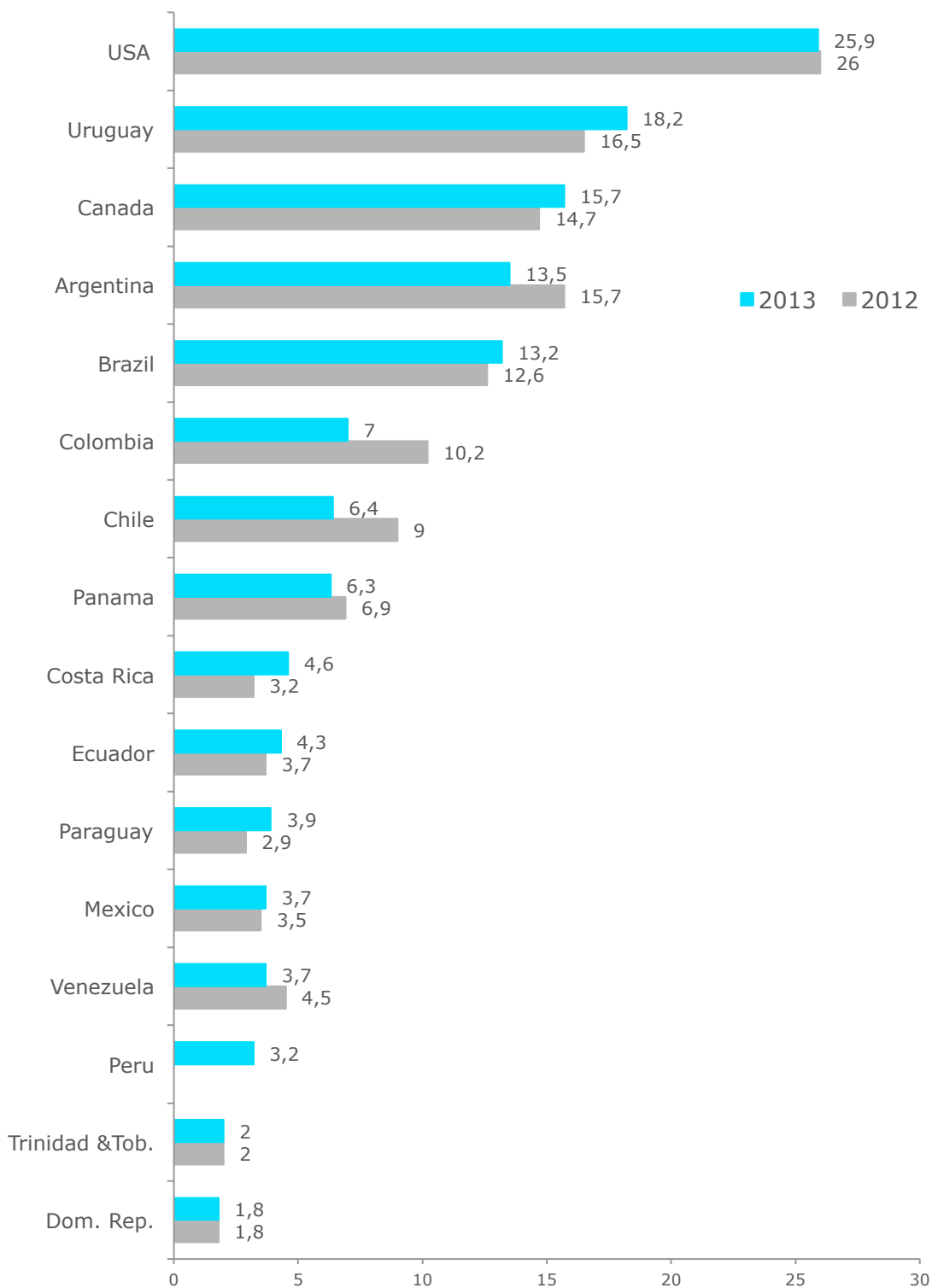

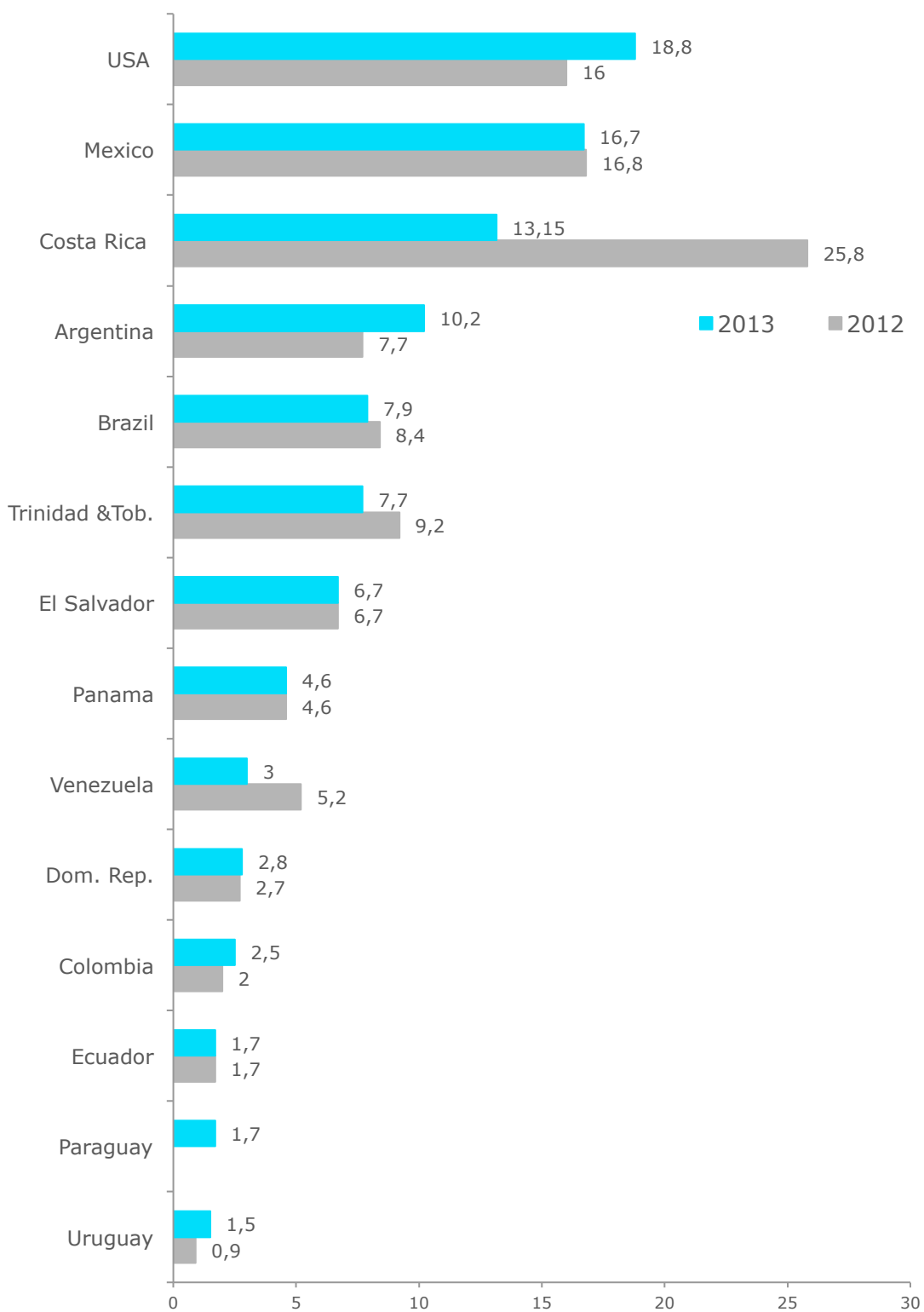




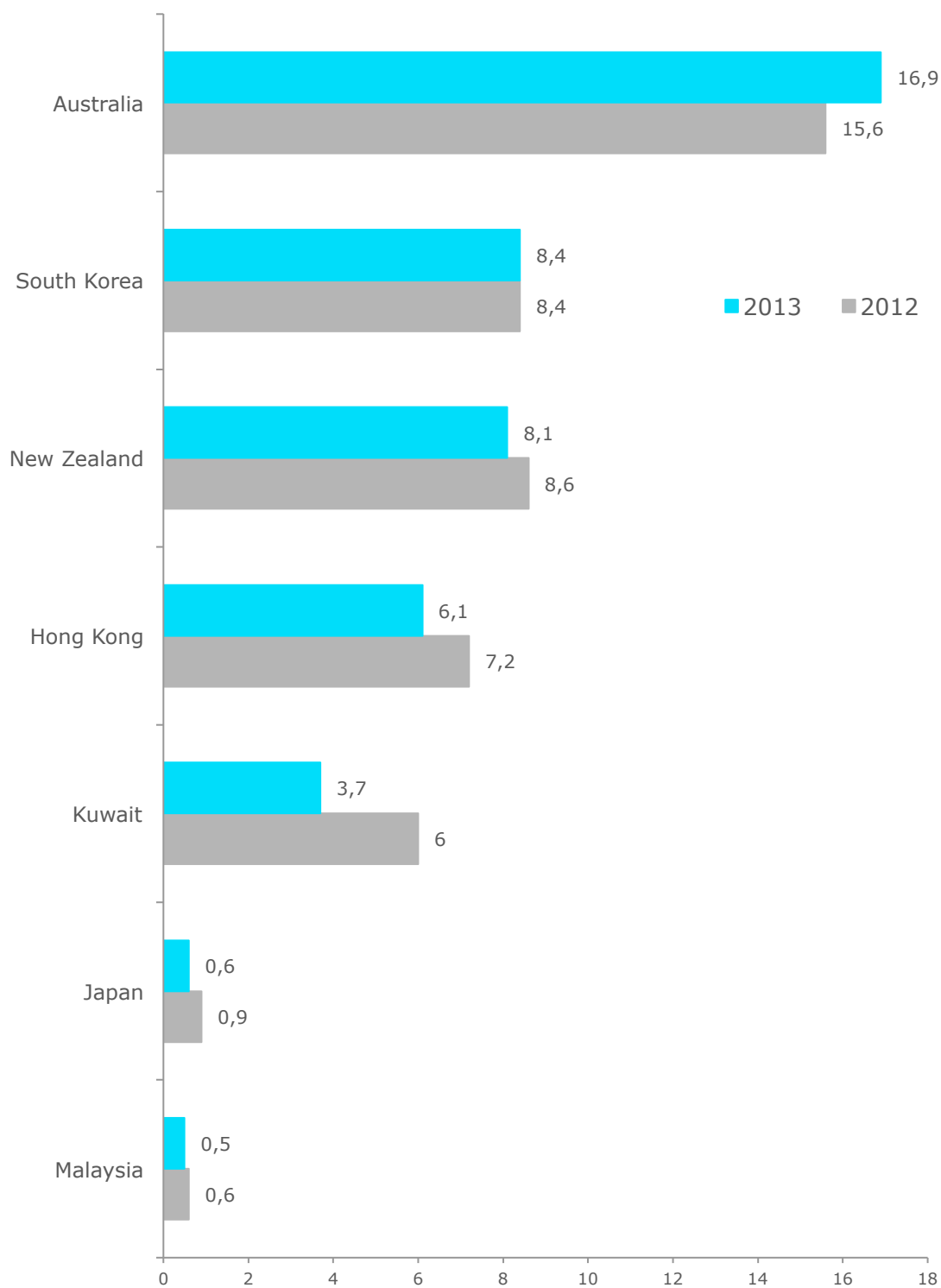
### AMERICA ACTUAL DECEASED ORGAN DONORS 2013 (pmp)



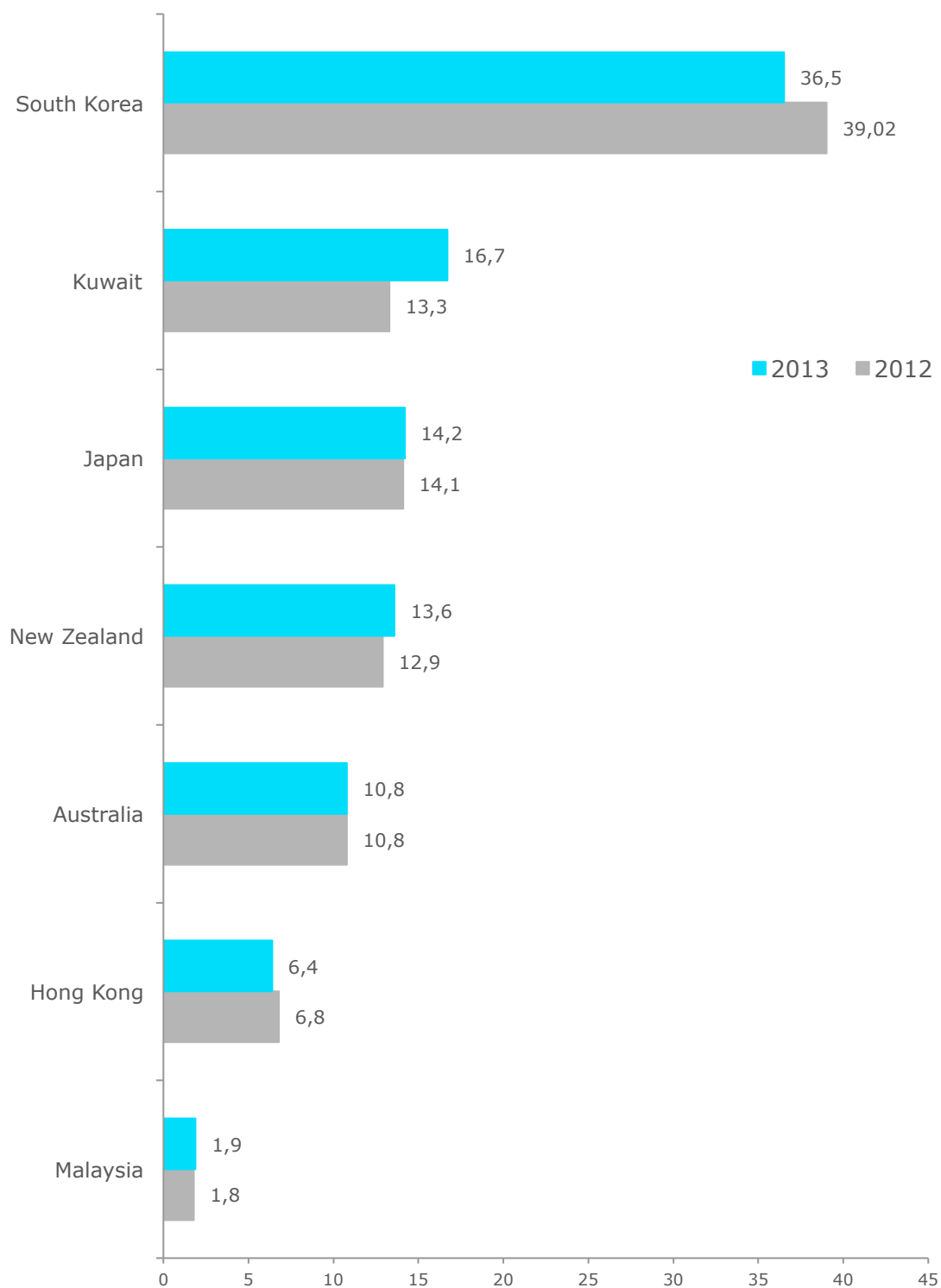

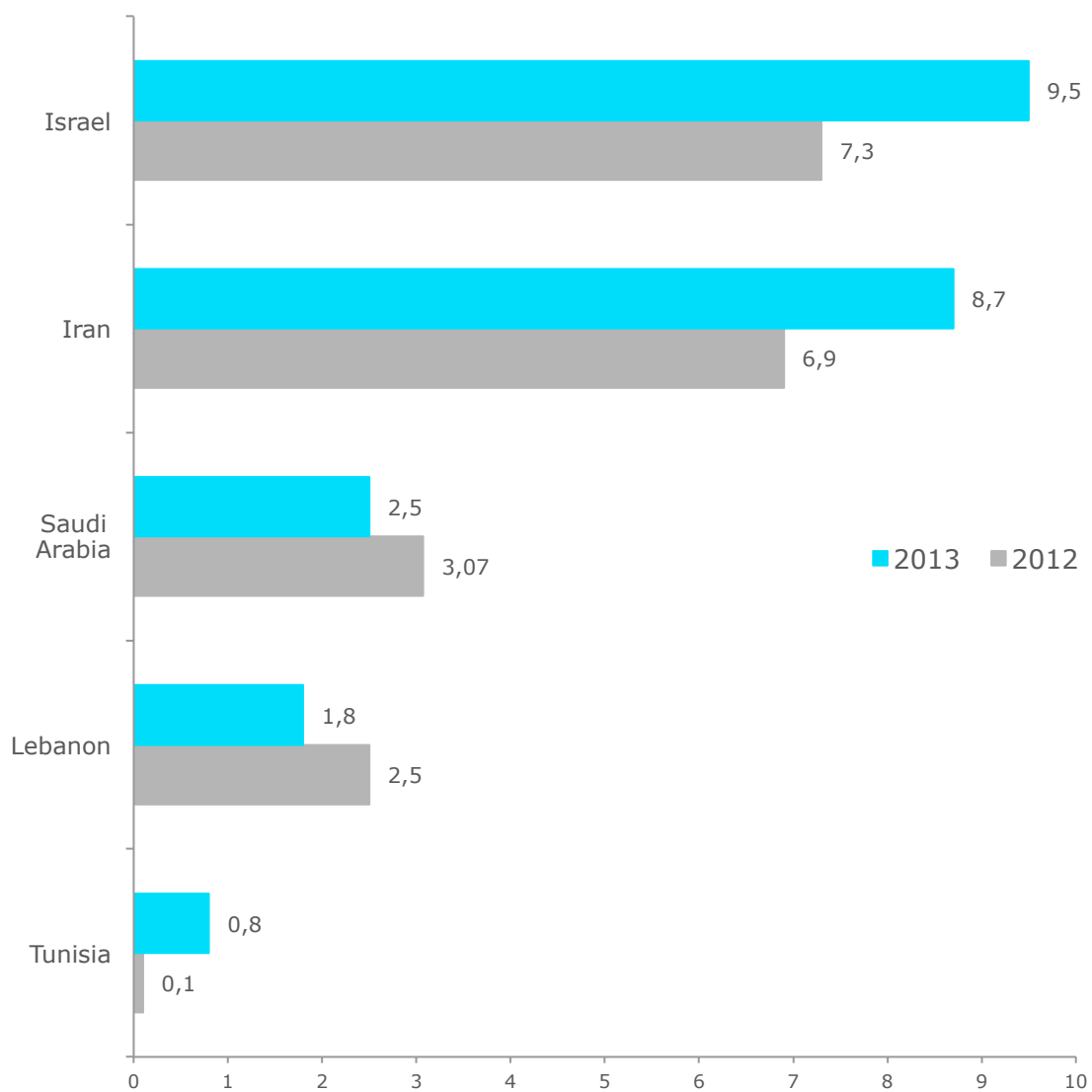
**ASIA-OCEANIA ACTUAL DECEASED ORGAN DONORS 2013 (pmp)**



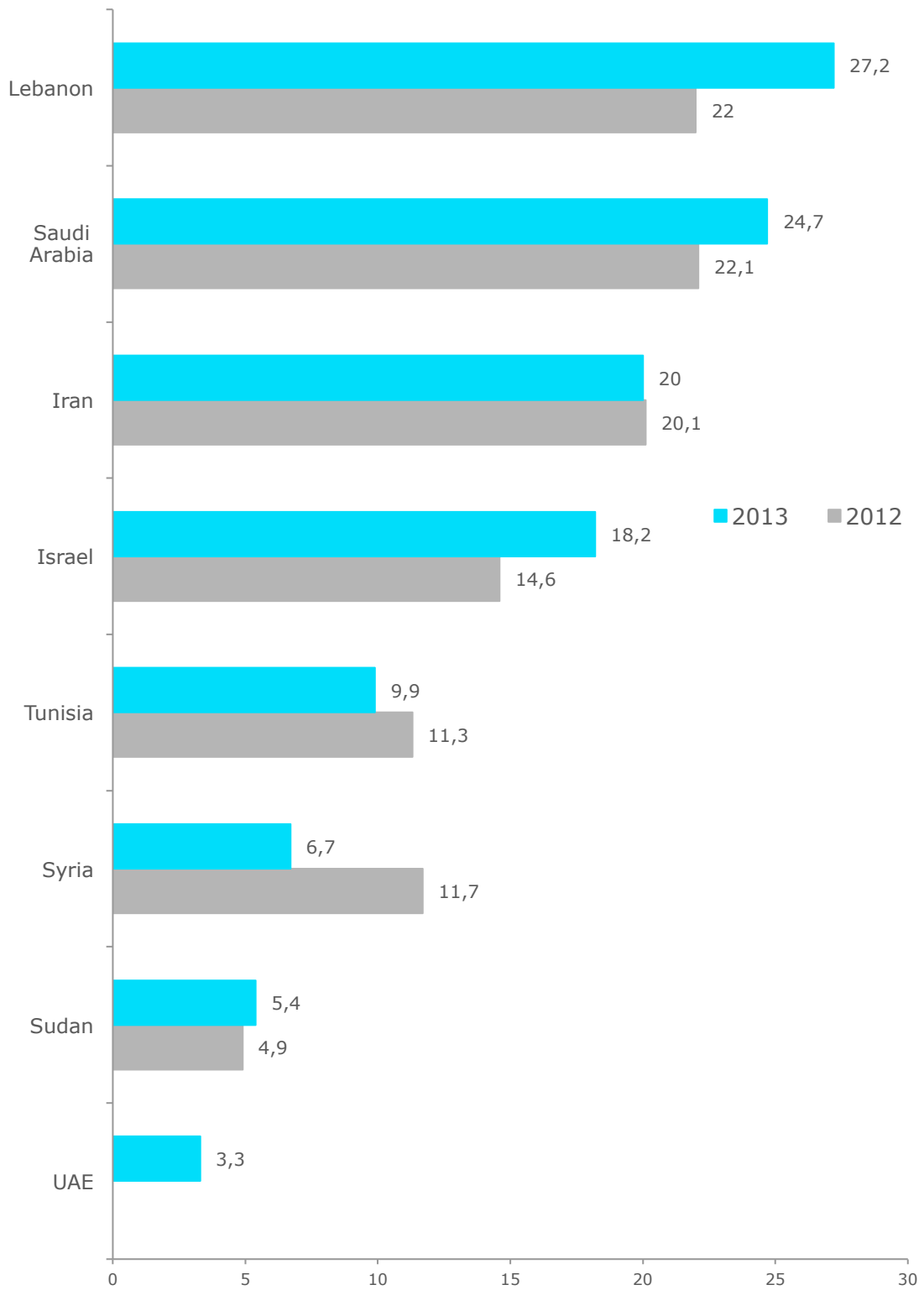

## 2. TRANSPLANTATION ACTIVITY

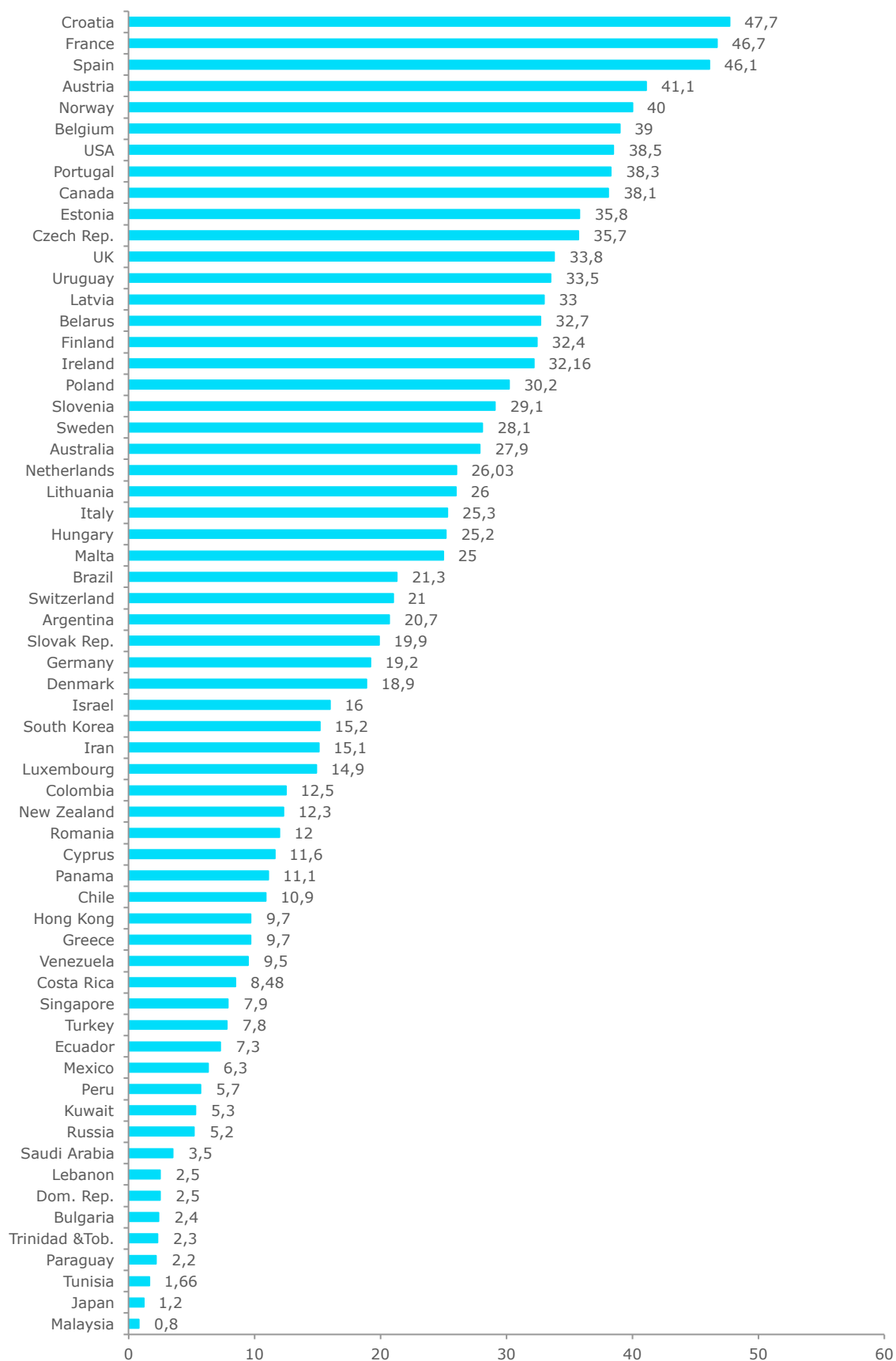

All graphs are represented in pmp, and the case of transplant from deceased donors' numbers had included all combinations.

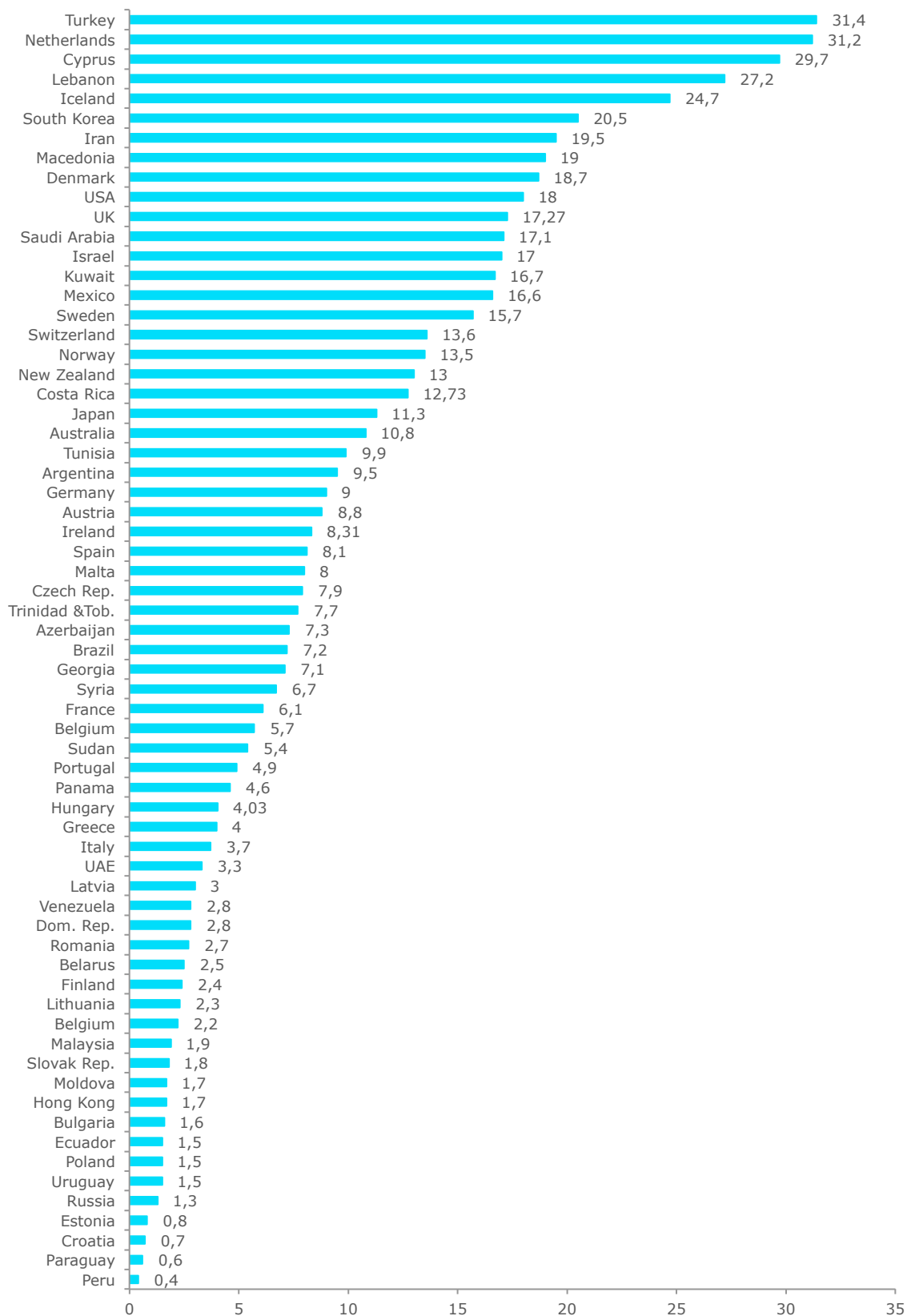

**WORLDWIDE KIDNEY TRANSPLANT FROM DECEASED DONORS 2013 (pmp)**

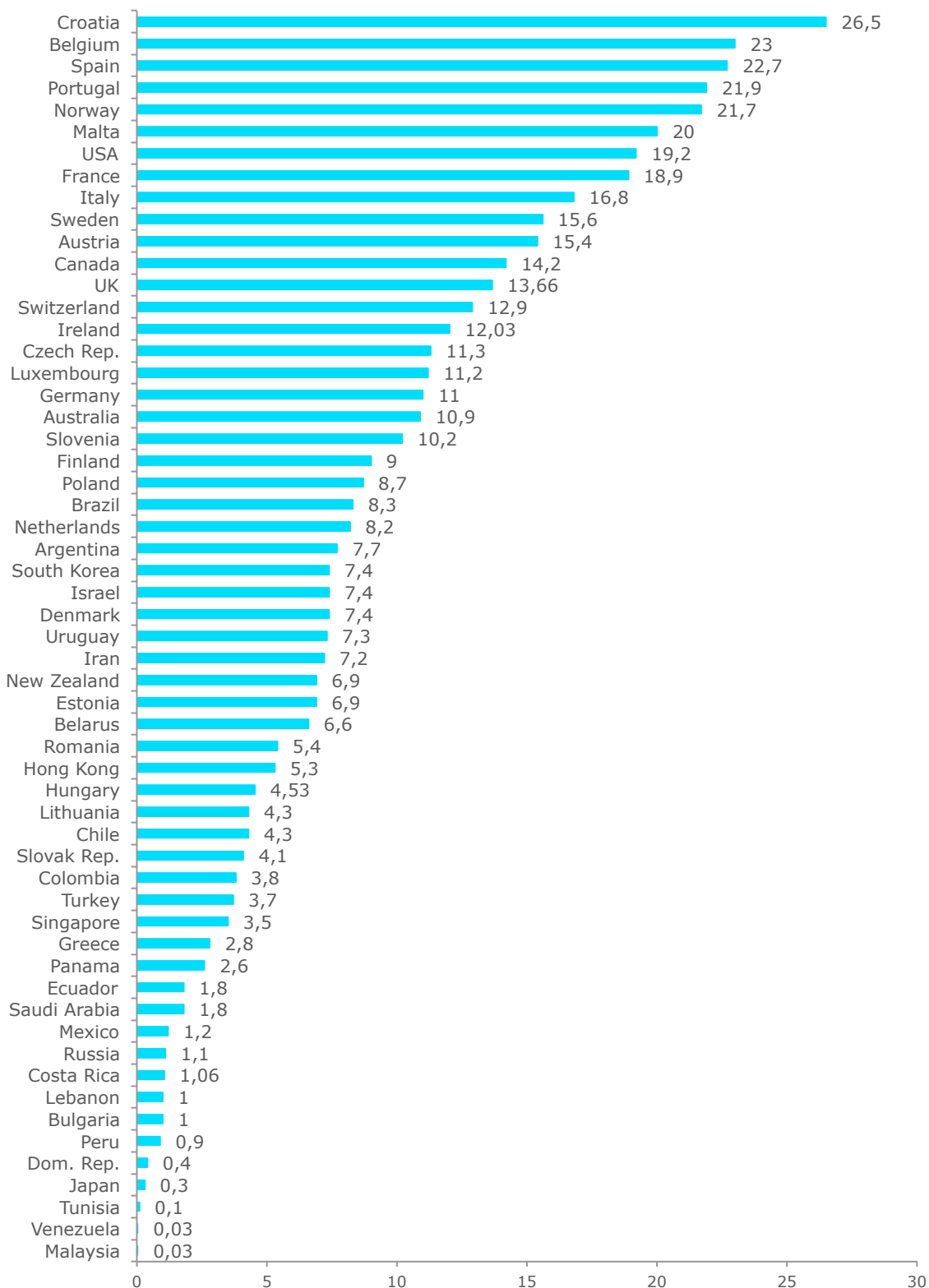




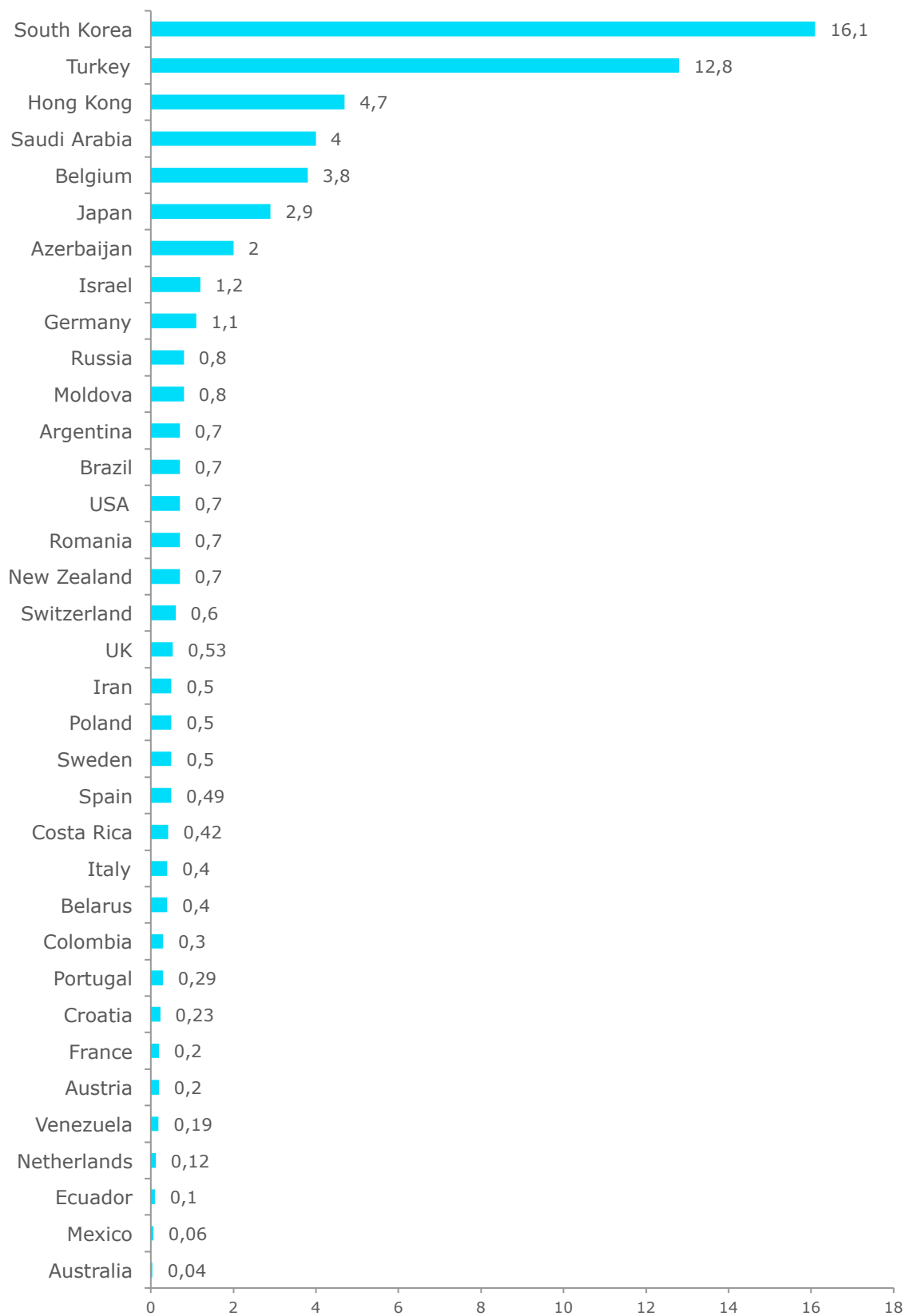
### WORLDWIDE KIDNEY TRANSPLANT FROM LIVING DONORS 2013 (pmp)



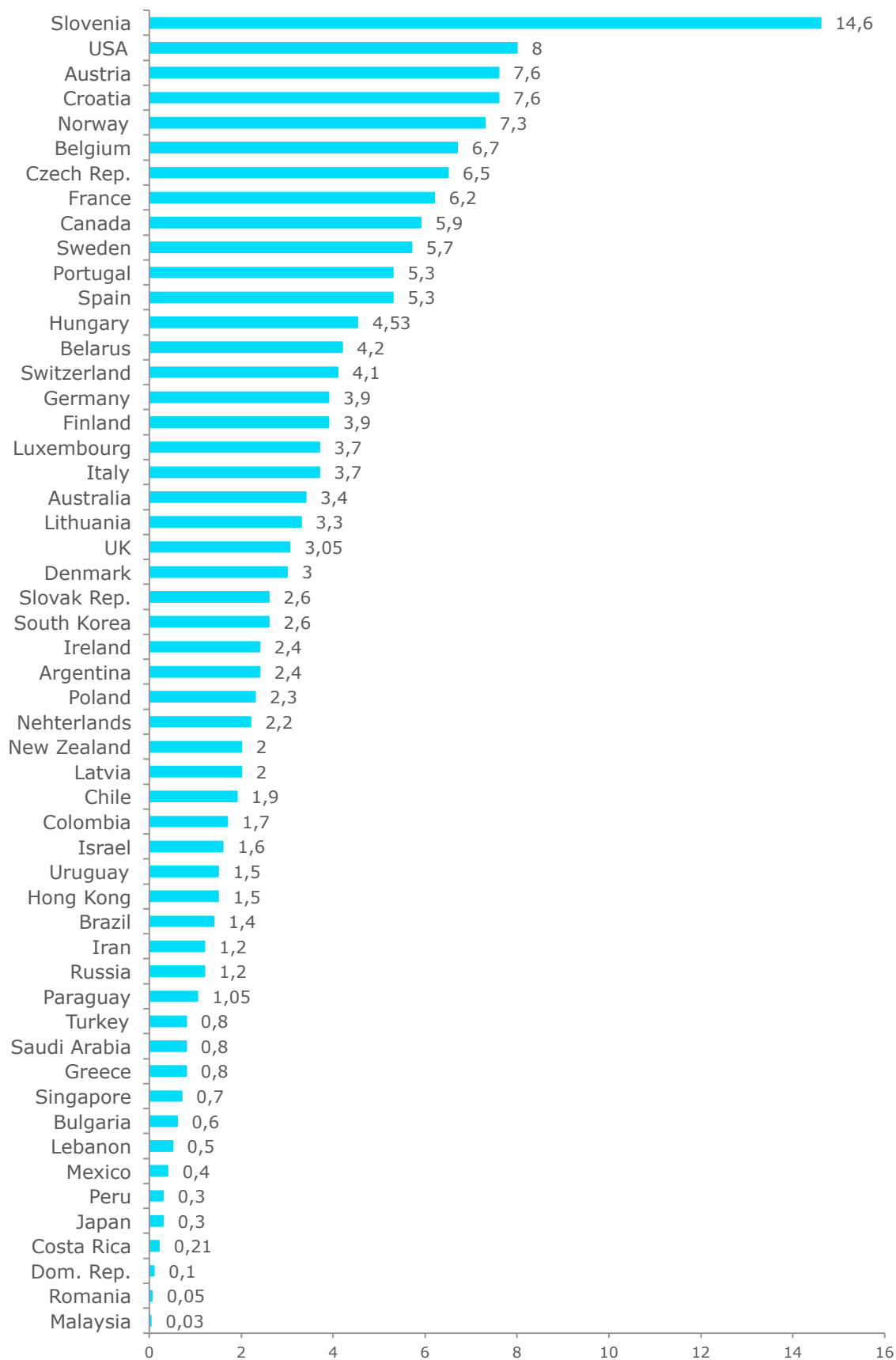
### WORLDWIDE LIVER TRANSPLANT FROM DECEASED DONORS 2013 (pmp)



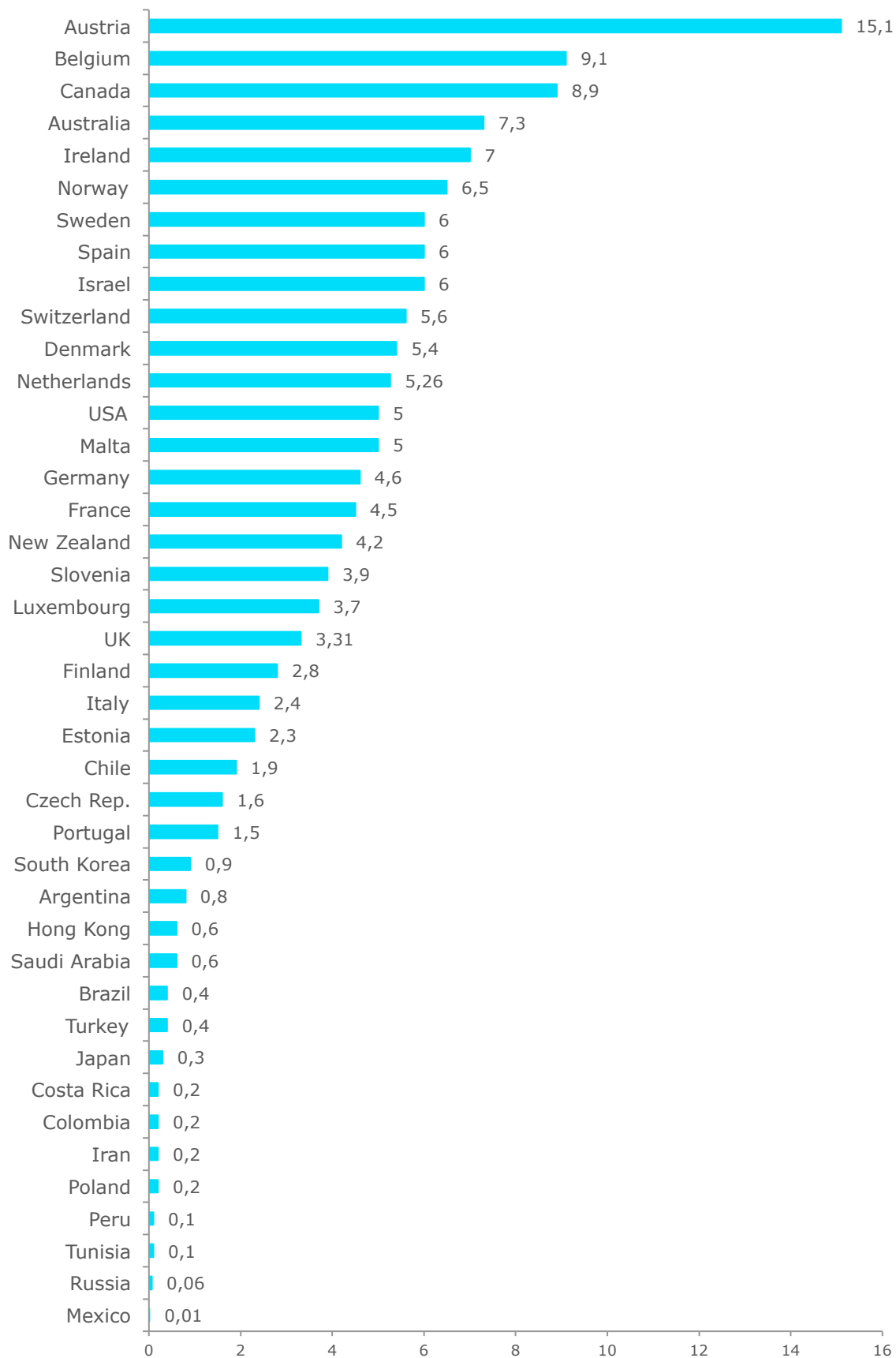
### WORLDWIDE LIVER TRANSPLANT FROM LIVING DONORS 2013 (pmp)



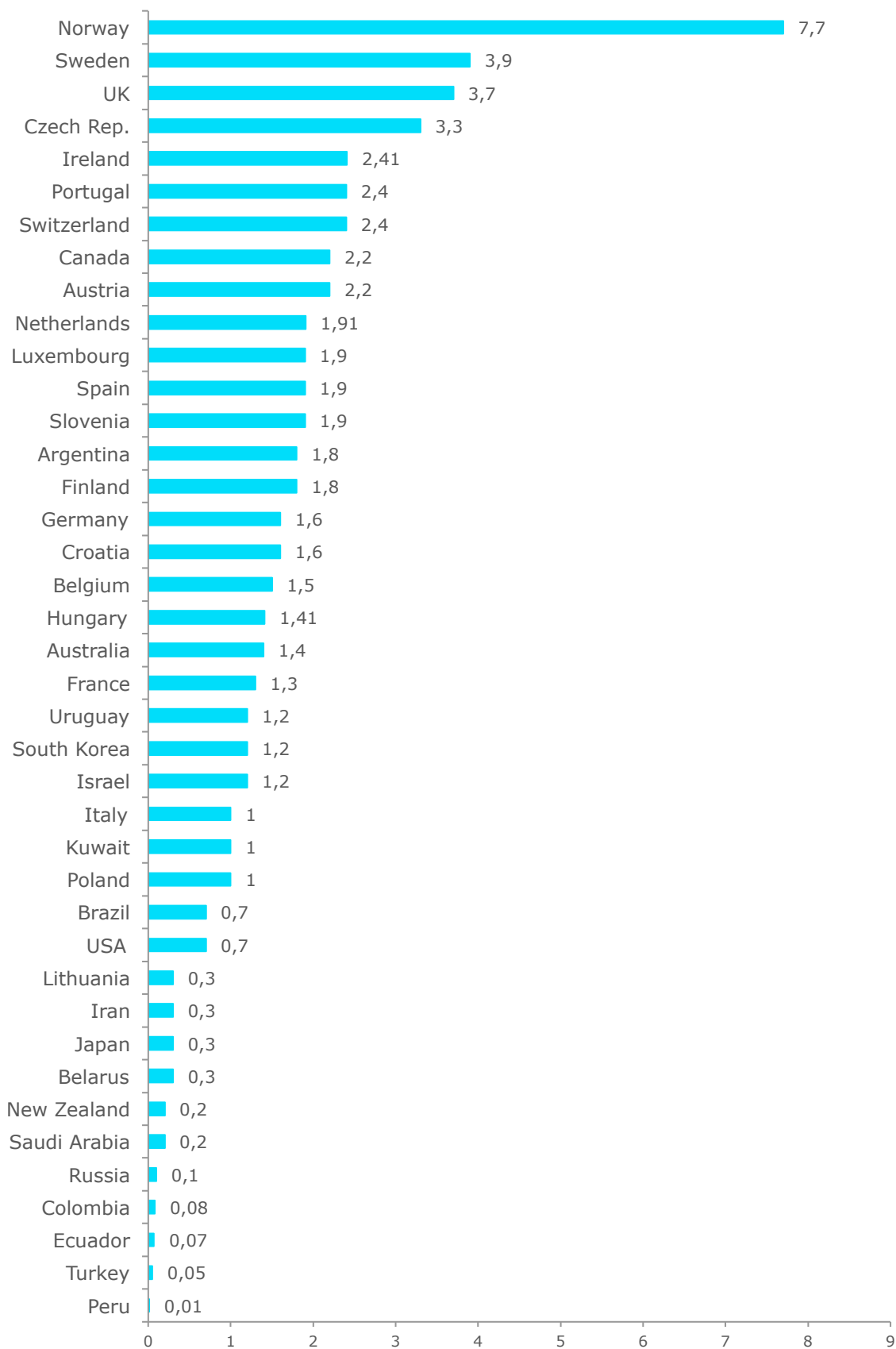
